

PACE West Tiered Interventions for Behavior

Tier 1

- **Tier 1 (80-90% of students)**
- **INTERVENTION:** Classroom & Counselor managed behaviors, PBIS, Point sheets, Social Skills groups, FBA, small group classrooms, Restorative conferences. Short breaks with staff or counselor, drawing, doodling, fidget toys/manipulatives, sensory breaks
- Behaviors causing minimal to minor interference of the instructional process
- Behaviors creating a threatening, distressful, disturbance to the students involved

Tier 2

- **Tier 2 (5-15% of students)**
- **INTERVENTION:** Solutions Within a School/Alt schedule; classroom evacuation & get counselor to assist, 1:1 cognitive processing; skill streamming, social skills role play; journaling; contact with outside agencies/mental health counselors; safety plan
- Behaviors causing maximum interference of the instructional process and/or causing a safety

Tier 3

- **Tier 3 (1-5% of students)**
- **INTERVENTIONS:** Administrative intervention and/or Police involvement deemed by Principal or Admin in charge; 1:1 student/staff ratio, restorative conferences collaborate with community services, counseling as needed, refer to CCS; refer to Emergency Mental health Assessment
- Behaviors surpassing Tiers 1 & 2 causing a safety risk to harm self, students, and/or staff. Or excessive disruption to the schools educational process continually during one episode or on a consistent basis .
- Behaviors considered criminal activity/violation of student code of conduct; safety risk to harm self, students or staff
